4.3% ABV pint £3.30 half £1.65

With minimal carbonation which tones down the bitterness, this Meantime Ale still manages a unique balance of apple fresh flavours with hints of honey and biscuit. The dry hopping technique gives it a truly tantalizing aroma

Broadside, Adnams, England

4.7% ABV pint £3.30 half £1.65

Brewed to celebrate the Battle of Sole Bay in 1672, the ale has had a sharp rise to fame with its rich fruit cake aroma's-almonds, zest and conserved fruit. An easy drinking pint with a wonderful balance of malt and hop flavours

St Edmunds, Greene King, England

4.2% ABV pint £3.20 half £1.60

This fresh and zesty 'blonde beer' is specially brewed to be served 6-8 degrees cooler than traditional cask beers. A delightful golden crisp finish to a smooth hoppy ale

Landlord Strong Pale Ale, Timothy Taylor, Yorkshire

4.1% ABV 500ml £3.95

Deep golden with a ruby sheen and a thick, pillowy head. Full of fresh aromas with crisp herbal notes and citrus fruit. On the palate it has a rich texture and a bitter spectrum of flavours with hints of spinach, leafy greens and minerals. There's a biscuity note of malt in the finish

Organic Honey Dew, Fuller's, London

5.0% ABV 500ml £3.95

A golden beer brewed entirely from English organic malt with hops and laced with the finest organic honey. Wonderfully aromatic on the nose and outstandingly smooth. The natural sweetness is perfectly counterbalanced by Target hops, which provide a zesty finish

Wheat Grand Cru, Meantime, London

6.5% ABV 330ml £3.65

A cloudy, golden-orange beer with a medium dense head. Displayed mixed banana, bubblegum, spice and zest notes. In true Bavarian wheat beer style these flavours are created by a yeast strain that brings out of character of the wheat malt. Used. The haze comes from lack of filtration

Strawberry Pear Cider, Brothers, Somerset

4.0% ABV 500ml £3.95

From an established cider making family but only recently available outside Somerset. A unique blend of strawberry and pear, bright in colour and bursting with ripe fruit flavours

Raspberry Grand Cru, Meantime, London

6.5% ABV 330ml £3.65

Dry and full of fruit, with a light bitterness. Refreshing sharp raspberry flavours but with a good balancing sweetness and makes an excellent match with cheese and fruit desserts

Chocolate Beer, Meantime, London

6.5% abv 330ml £3.65

Soothing flavours of malt barley given an extra dimension by the addition of hints of dark chocolate. The vanilla and fruit make this a fine companion to casseroles and desserts

Brewed with Zatec hops and Moravian barley, Budvar is lagered (cold conditioned) for three months to produce its unique character. This is one of the longest maturation periods for light beers

Beck's, Brauerei Beck, Germany

5.0% ABV 275ml £3.10

Light coloured with a crisp refreshing taste that's full of character. Brewed in Bremen according to the German Purity Law which only allows natural ingredients of barley, hops, yeast and water in the brewing process

Alcohol free Beck's, Brauerei Beck, Germany

0.05% ABV 275ml £3.10

Brewed using the same method as the regular Beck's but then de-alcoholised at the end of the process so it still has the same great taste

Nastro Azzuro, Peroni, Italy

5.1% ABV 330ml £3.10

Peroni's Nastro Azzurro (Blue Ribbon) is an established brand in the UK, having been imported since 1965. This premium beer is brewed using the finest two-row spring planted malting barley

Corona Extra, Grupo Modelo, Mexico

A light copper colour with an inviting aroma. Made with Fuggle and Goldings hops. Full of tart citrus fruit, ginger and marmalade notes overlaid with rich marzipan. 'India style' ales are characterised by pale malts, long maturation, massive hopping levels and high alcoholic strength

Bulmers Original, Herefordshire

4.5% ABV 568ml £3.95

Brewed with English apples and chill-filtered at zero degrees to give a pure, crisp, refreshing flavour and natural character

Oak Aged Beer, Innis & Gunn, Scotland

6.6% ABV 330ml £3.50

Aged in brand new malt whisky barrels made from American oak. Intense aromas of fresh, grassy hops and a deep, almost briny note. The oak is noticeable as luscious hints of vanilla and caramel. The freshness of the hops cuts through this sweetness and the acidity is clean in the finish

Light to medium hazy gold, with a dense head. Aromas of clove, spices and lemon, overlaid with rich malt and a hint of ripe fruit. On the palate it is yeasty with white chocolate notes, citrus fruit and an underlying bitterness. Retains very good balance and acidity
